Hirris State University has received \$8,000,711 from the federal Higher Fituration Emergency Relief Fund (HHRF) to provide emergency financial aid grants to eligible students due to the financial impact of coronavirus. The federal government requires that institutions prioritize students with exceptional need, such as students who receive Rell Grants, in awarding financial aid grants to students. Since many students have been impacted financially by the coronavirus, the Financial Aid Office used the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to identify students with the most financial need. To date, over \$7,200,000 of the funds have been awarded to more than \$300 eligible students. Students neceiving awards were entified on Tuesday, March 9

Students that didnot neet the initial awarding criteria and can demonstrate externating firm cial need may submit a detailed explanation for consideration of grant funds through an ordine application process. The application will be posted on March 19 2021 to the Firm cial Aid Office website.
